GLENBURN HOUSE
WISEMANS CREEK

Come and relax at GLENBURN HOUSE located at Wisemans Creek only two and half hours from Sydney and twenty minutes from Bathurst and Oberon. GLENBURN HOUSE is only forty minutes from Jenolan Caves and Kanangra Boyd National Park and ten minutes from Mayfield Gardens.

Wisemans Creek was the scene of gold, silver and copper mining during the 1870s to early 1900s with a population of several hundred people. Today it offers a rural lifestyle to its less than a dozen permanent residents. The countryside is picturesque and hilly with a mixture of grassy paddocks and eucalypt-forested slopes.

GLENBURN HOUSE started life in 1883 as a school in the village of Glenburn, known to the locals as Wisemans Creek. Jennifer and Malcolm fell in love with the old school and have since made sympathetic additions to convert it to a stylish and appealing residence enhanced by artistic furnishings and original paintings.



ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation consists of three guest rooms, all separate from the main house, each with en-suite, plus the old school room which is now a welcoming guest sitting room with open fire. Verandahs, terraces and a spacious garden provide many other delightful spots to sit and relax.

Cooked or continental breakfast is included. For evening meals why not try the local O'Connell Hotel or one of the many fine restaurants in Bathurst or Oberon.

If you want to get out and about, the district offers many attractions, including Jenolan Caves and Mayfield Gardens, plus mushrooming in season or for the more energetic horse riding, trout fishing, bushwalking and bike riding. But if you want to simply sit and enjoy the peace of the country you can relax by the fire or find a chair in the garden. Once night has fallen, don't forget to check out the starry sky.

FACILITIES

- Three 'queen' guest rooms, all with spacious ensuites;
- All guest rooms are separate from the main house, two are located in a separate guest pavilion and the third is in a separate private spot in the garden;
- Balcony Room has its own private verandah; Courtyard Room has the luxury of a full size bath tub; Terrace Room has its own private deck;
- For summer cooling: ceiling fans in two of the guest rooms, floor fan in the third;
- For winter heating: under-floor heating in all bathrooms and electric heaters in all bedrooms;
- TV and DVD player in all bedrooms;
- Guest sitting room (former school room) with open fire;
- Continental or cooked breakfast served in dining room or in the garden if weather permits.

TARIFF

- \$200 per queen room, per couple, per day, including breakfast

CONDITIONS

- We accept Mastercard, Visa or bank transfer
- 50% deposit is required on booking
- Tariffs are subject to change without notice
- Check-in time is 3.00 pm; check-out time is 11.00am
- Glenburn House is SMOKE FREE within the buildings
- Note that there is no mobile telephone reception at the house. Reception is available two minutes drive away at the top of the hill.
- Glenburn House is pet friendly.
